The membership year is October 1 to September 30. Dues will not be prorated if a member joins in mid-year. Individuals joining prior to April 1 will be paid members through the end of the current year.

Individuals joining on or after April 1 will be paid members through the next year. Examples:

1) Member joins on March 10, 2016 and is then paid up through September 30, 2016.

2) Member joins on April 20, 2016 and is then paid up through September 30, 2017.

Members who do not renew their membership by December 31 of each year will be dropped from the active rolls and cease to receive Nutcracker Notes (although they may still receive notices for the annual meeting and an occasional letter inviting them to rejoin). Renewal can be at any level the member is eligible for regardless of what was their initial membership level.

Membership Benefits: Members receive an annual subscription to the Nutcracker Notes magazine, a vote in elections, participation in annual meetings, discounts on Foundation merchandise, and access to the Members Only area of the Foundation’s web site. Membership at the Grizzly Level is a lifetime membership and annual dues are not assessed. Annual membership dues paid minus the cost of the Nutcracker Notes subscription are tax deductible.
